A Positive Message of Service

I attended the admin team meeting in November and we addressed the comments and questions in the Area Inventory. I realized that it's important to share a positive message about what being of service at the Area level means to me. I had spent many years in the "hallway," rather than participating in my recovery within the rooms of Narcotics Anonymous...Moving to Sacramento in 2009 and coming back to active NA membership, it was important to end my complacency and stop isolating. Starting in group level service as a GSR, and later as the H&I Secretary was just what I needed to learn about the service structure and give back what was so freely given to me.
