RCM's Report

Deborah and I attended Region on 12/12/15 giving our Area 2 votes. There were 18 out of 21 Areas left on the roster in attendance and 26 RCM's present.

The FST Chair shared the Northern California Circle of Sisters bid for 2018 was going to be submitted Dec. 22nd, 2015 and will be presented in February at the Dallas Circle of Sisters. The committee has collected about 25 resumes of women willing to help.

The Regional Resource Coordinator is asking for volunteers to fill out the Regional Resource Pool Forms. They can be found at <http://www.norcalna.org/RRPForm.html> and given to your RCM or sent to rrc@ncrsc.org. Also a reminder that elections are coming up in 6 months for NCCNA, FST, and BOD. I will have a list of positions available in a future report.

NCCNA reported that only \$170.04 remain from NCCNA 37 Newcomer Fund due to the amount of requests last year. A Motion was written to create a stimulus prudent reserve account by a one-time donation of \$9,000.00 from the NCRSC discretionary fund in support of the Newcomer Registrations for NCCNA 38. It was passed 29 for, 7 against, and 1 abstention. They are still in need of volunteers and asking everyone to pre-register if possible on line or by mail using the NCCNA brochure. There are still 2 positions open on the committee; Arts and Graphics and Program Advisor.

The BOD Rep. shared a new NCRSO Special Event Insurance Packet has been posted on the [norcalna.org](http://www.norcalna.org) website. <http://store.norcalna.org/pdf/NCRSO%20Special%20Event%20Insurance%20packet.pdf> Also that UPS shipping cost will be increasing by 4.9% starting Dec.28, 2015. The BOD will be purchasing new gift items from various vendors and will have a booth at TAC in January with some of these items available. The SALES REPORT: November gift sales = \$8,456.00 and literature sales = \$25,329.00 for a total of \$33,785.00. October gift sales = \$6,970.15 and literature sales = \$26,708.47 for a total of \$33,678.62. I have a full BOD Annual Report available for review if you are interested. I also have a copy of the Northern California Regional Service Committee Guidelines available for review.

We spent the better part of 5 hours going over a summary of the World Board Report in the Conference Agenda Report. PLEASE SAVE THE DATE AND LET YOUR GROUPS KNOW WE WILL BE HAVING A CAR WORKSHOP ON February 27th, 2016 from 1:00-5:00. The location is still being worked on and fliers will be available at the next ASC. There will be refreshments and a knowledgeable team to present the workshop and answer any questions so you can make an informed vote.

The Regional Delegates also reported the World Convention in Rio de Janeiro had a loss of \$384,710.00 due to the extra expense for HVAC and lack of communication with the hotels trying to use 3 different vendors.

The illicit literature is an ongoing issue. NAWS stand is DON'T PARTICIPATE. There was talk about a lawsuit and NAWS is not going to fight it because NA funds will be loss. Keep in mind this is not approved literature and goes against the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust.
