RCM's Report

Good evening everyone! The RSC (Regional Service Committee) did not meet for the month of August however they did send out an Electronic Newsletter. Here is some information regarding the NCCNA Committee. The NCCNA had their first onsite walkthrough of the Sacramento facility for NCCNA 39 and they had no concerns at this time. The NCCNA Contract team has asked for a review of venues for the conventions 2 cycles in the future. There were 3 options that were proposed:

- Continue with current cycle of Sacramento, San Jose, and Santa Clara
- Change to a 2-year cycle for Sacramento and a 4-year cycle for San Jose and Santa Clara
- Eliminate Santa Clara and go to a 2-year Sacramento and San Jose cycle

Additional considerations about Santa Clara were: lack of additional lower cost hotels and restaurants in the immediate area. Sacramento has many other hotel options other than the host hotels and has a large selection of restaurants around the facility. The Levi Stadium being built will bring higher costs for other local services in Santa Clara and increased AV costs at Santa Clara that are continuing to rise.

Extensive discussions were held including the bids we received for Sacramento and Santa Clara for NCCNA 41. The following are the numbers contracts received as bids for each facility for NCCNA 41: Sacramento \$41,256 and Santa Clara \$71,310.00.
