Good evening! I attended Region on 11/12/16 and there were 17 out of 22 Areas present. There will not be a RSC meeting in December; the next one will be January 14, 2017. This report will be short and sweet!

The Treasurer has asked us to take back to our Area's about the need of money that the RSC needs to operate. They are asking that every group in our region contribute \$5.00 a month. We have 55 groups in our area, which is a \$275.00 per month contribution. The Fellowship Service Team (FST) would be willing to do a presentation on how and where the money is distributed at Region. If they do not have the money for operating costs, it could then come at the cost of raising the price on literature.

The Regional Delegate (RD) reported that NAWS announced that *Guiding Principles: The Spirit of Our Traditions* is available for purchase for \$11 in hardcover (item 1201) or softcover (item 1202). You can order the book at <http://www.na.org/?ID=OrderLiteratureOnline-content>. NA is growing through Literature Translations, PR and Fellowship Development; there are currently over 68,000 weekly meetings worldwide. New NA meetings are being registered each day. Iran has 23,000 meetings per week and has 20 areas. The basic text is now available in 28 languages, with four more translations in process. Based on the straw poll results from the World Service Conference (WSC), NAWS will be seeking Fellowship input on two pieces of new literature: a new daily meditation guide based on *Spiritual Principles* and /or *Living Clean* and a new IP on *Mental Health* (as mentioned above). Lastly the NA Recovery companion app is available for purchase. Some features include interactive app that has a call-your-sponsor button, and you can also share step work.

NCCNA reported that registration is now open. They are selling a combination packet that includes registration, T-shirt, and tickets to New Q Comedy and Blues Breakfast. They are also taking bids for NCCNA 40 in San Jose.

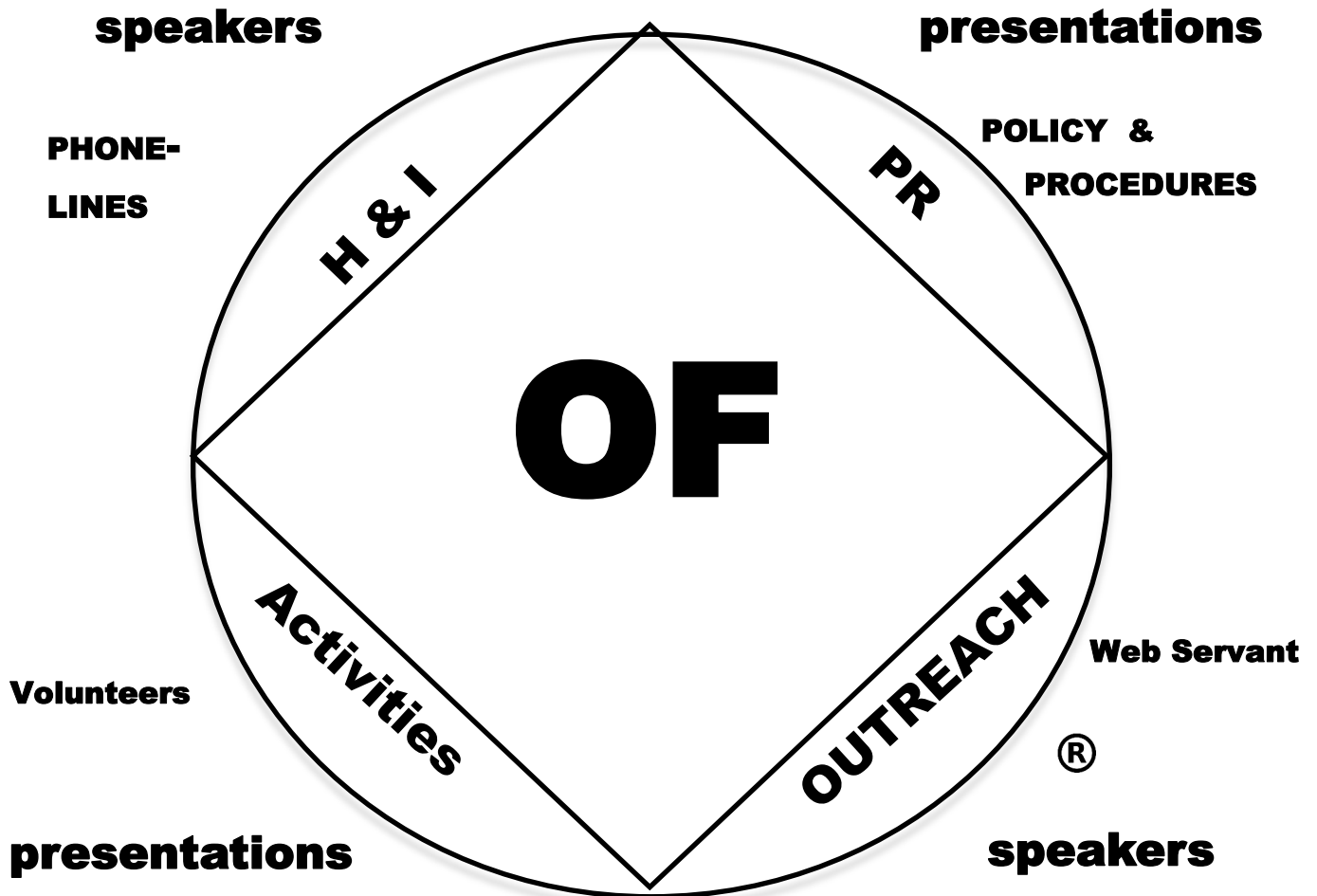
Circle of Sisters reported that there are 4 seats that are open: Vice-Chair, Vice-Treasurer, Member at Large 3, and Co-Secretary.
