Policy and Procedure Report

Policy and Procedure Report: February 1, 2017

<u>ASC Trusted Servants</u>: I attended the SacFNA Admin Team meeting on January18th. We welcomed Javier C. #2 as our new RCM, and Jeff as our new Schedules Task Leader. I updated the admin team passwords for both of them plus the password for Javier C. #1's (Outreach Task Leader).

Regular Meeting Insurance: The Northern California Regional Service Office (NCRSO) insurance policy provides liability coverage in and directly around meetings of Narcotics Anonymous (NA) for the duration of the meeting from set-up through clean -up. It does not cover any area of the facility that is not required to access, attend and/or leave the meeting. A meeting is covered as long as it is considered a standard meeting (weekly, bi-weekly, or monthly) and is included in the local area NA meeting schedule or online schedule, (including the regular business meeting). Email Nina P. at policyprocedure.sacfna@gmail.com with any questions.

FAQs about Special Event Coverage:

1. What is a Special Event?

Special events are not covered by the NCRSO regular insurance policy; they require additional insurance to protect the group and the area from being sued in the event of an accident, damage, or loss. Special events need extra insurance for *events that occurs beyond the regular meeting time* posted in the meeting schedule. They include but are not limited to dances, pancake breakfasts, spaghetti feeds, golf tournaments, campouts, hikes, softball games, unity days, area conventions, and holiday marathons.

- 2. How much notice does the NCRSO need to process special insurance needs?
 - If the forms are received <u>30 days</u> or more prior to the event, a payment of **\$25** is required with the forms.
 - If the forms are received LESS than 30 days prior to the event, an "expediting fee" of \$25 will be added to the \$25 certificate fee, or a total of \$50.
 - If the forms are received LESS than 15 days prior to the event, an "expediting fee" of \$50 will be added to the \$25 certificate fee, for a total of \$75.

If you are having an NA event at a meeting location that is outside the scheduled meeting times, you will need to purchase an event insurance certificate.
