Hi everyone,

I attended the admin team meeting in April and we discussed policies for making a police report, or filing a home-owner's or renter's insurance claim, or auto insurance claim, if a situation occurs and SacFNA equipment is stolen. We also provided the following information to ARANA to review why meetings are taken out of the schedule. To make certain, members are aware of our guidelines, would you kindly bring the following information back to your group business meetings.

#### **WHY IS IT IMPORTANT THAT GROUPS SEND A GSR TO AREA**

Our Guidelines in Section 4, article 3 - Area Member Requirements states, " For the purpose of defining eligible groups that are qualified to be published on the schedule and included in the Quorum of Sac FNA only groups that are represented are covered by the insurance provided by the Northern California region of Narcotics Anonymous."

- Item A: that group must have a participating GSR or alternate GSR in attendance at the SacFNA area meetings. Participation is defined as attending each area monthly meeting with no more than three consecutive absences.
- Item B: after two consecutive missed ASC meetings, the group will be contacted by Outreach or an appointed admin person to verify if a GSR can in the next ASC.
- Item C: groups will be removed from the schedule and the Quorum of the SacFNA at the end of the third consecutive absence.
- Item D: The active status will be restored to removed group when the group is represented by a GSR or alternate GSR at a future Sac FNA meeting; the group will then be added to the schedule. "
